

EHS Summer School Registration Form—Summer of 2017

Edgewood High School summer school will take place **Tuesday, May 30th** through **Thursday, June 22nd**. There is no fee for regular summer school courses; however, there is a \$15 fee for our Apex online summer courses.

Important Notes:

1. Summer school hours are from 8:00 a.m.-11:45 a.m.; students must arrive by 7:45 a.m. on May 30th.
2. We cannot yet say with certainty that any particular class will take place. For each class, a minimum of 15 students must be signed up for that class to take place. Late sign-ups will be accepted if space is available.
3. **Direct bus transportation will not be provided this year.** Arrangements are being made for possible pick-up points throughout the district.
4. Due to the amount of material covered each day, attendance in summer school is very important. Students cannot miss any days, regardless of the reason, and receive credit for a summer school class.

English and Math Courses

English and math courses will be offered in either a regular classroom setting or via Apex from 8:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. Students can take one semester (first or second) of one of the courses listed below for credit recovery (the student has already taken the course but did not earn credit).

Apex Online Courses

- There is a fee of \$15 for Apex online courses; this fee will be added to 2017-18 book fees.
- These are not the same as the Achieve Virtual Education Academy (AVEA) summer online courses.

Additional courses (not listed above) that are needed for credit recovery will be available online via our Apex online course program; however, no science courses will be available. Students enrolled in an Apex course must attend summer school from 8:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. Students will be encouraged to work on their Apex course outside of the regular school day. Apex courses must be completed by **Thursday June 22**; however, since the courses are self-paced, students will complete summer school as soon as they complete the Apex course. The advantage of an Apex summer course over an AVEA online summer course is that the Apex class is taken here at EHS with a teacher to assist the student.

Turn in the bottom portion of this form to the EHS School Counseling Office by **Friday, May 5th**. Students may register after May 5th if space is available.
